**Judging Criteria:** The Urban Conservation Award recognizes individuals, organizations or corporations in the urban setting for outstanding conservation achievements.

Applications will be reviewed by the District's awards committee and judges.

**To Apply:** Please fill out an application form and submit a typewritten narrative, which addresses the three items under 'Content Narrative.'

Every page should be identified by a number in the upper right hand corner corresponding to the item under Content Narrative to which the response applies. Supporting materials should be located after each response.
