Traumatic childhood events such as abuse, neglect, witnessing experiences such as crime, parental conflict, mental illness, and substance abuse can create dangerous levels of stress and derail healthy brain development—resulting in long-term effects on learning, behavior and health. Approaches are being developed to prevent adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) and mitigate their impact through building resilience.
