Objectives

The goal of the Tooth Ferry is to complete 1,500 encounters per year, visiting up to eight (8) schools. (The team has completed 59 encounters this year.)

Public Health Hygienist screens up to 8,000 students in elementary schools. (This year, we have screened 5,201.)

When the Tooth Ferry does not go out, the team will be expected to work within the clinic.

Issues

- There have been numerous mechanical issues (covered under warranty) including vehicle just being in for bump out (2nd time) and adjusting wiring for leveling system.
- Replace U-bolt missing in one area of the frame;
- Draft shaft adjusted;
- Repair to bump out switch so for engagement inside unit;
- o Initial generator service.
 - LifeLine has taken care of major repairs thus far.
- IT team has been out to address/test connectivity issues.
- Complexity of vehicle has required multiple trainings for the operators. (LifeLine has provided the team more than it typically provides its customers.)
- Smiles Van continues to convince schools to utilize their services.
- TF Coordinator often assisted in the clinic mid-October December to cover DA.



Next Steps

- Vehicle has had been in the shop to repair bump out and leveling system, and we are awaiting confirmation of next schools (Holt or R. N. Harris).
- Dental Director and Deputy to meet with Dr. Kendra
 O'Neal, newly appointed in DPS Hospital School.
- Re-evaluate dental contracts, staffing, etc.
- Report back to the Board by end of Fiscal Year.
