7. Public Hearing on the FY2007-2008 Recommended Budget

The Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing to receive citizen input on the FY 2007-08 recommended budget. 8. <u>Major Site Plan and Preliminary Plat—Ravenstone Phase III (D06-974)</u>

Approve a major site plan and preliminary plat for "Ravenstone Phase III" submitted by Horvath Associates, on behalf of Sherron Road Ventures LLC, for a 140 single-family-lot cluster subdivision on a 59.28-acre site, zoned RS-10(D) and F/J-B.

The plat includes a requested 18% reduction in lot area and setbacks for perimeter lots on the north, west and east boundaries. [The property is located south of Hillview Drive, west of Rondelay Drive, and east of Sherron Road. PINs 0860-03-15-1405, -01-16-2250]

The Development Review Board recommended approval on March 2, 2007 by a vote of 8-0.

Staff recommends approval.

9. Preliminary Resolution on 2007 General Obligation Bond

15 min.

The Board is requested to adopt a preliminary resolution which authorizes the County Administration to begin the process which would lead to a vote in November on the issuance of general obligation bonds by the County. Provided that the Preliminary Resolution is passed, the Preliminary Bond Order, which specifies the individual general obligation bonds which would be subject to voter approval and sets the date for the public hearing, would be presented to the Board at its next meeting. The Preliminary Resolution further authorizes the employment of Bond Counsel and further authorizes the filing of an application for the issuance of general obligation bonds with the Local Government Commission.

The total amount of the proposed GO bond issue is \$210,400,000.
