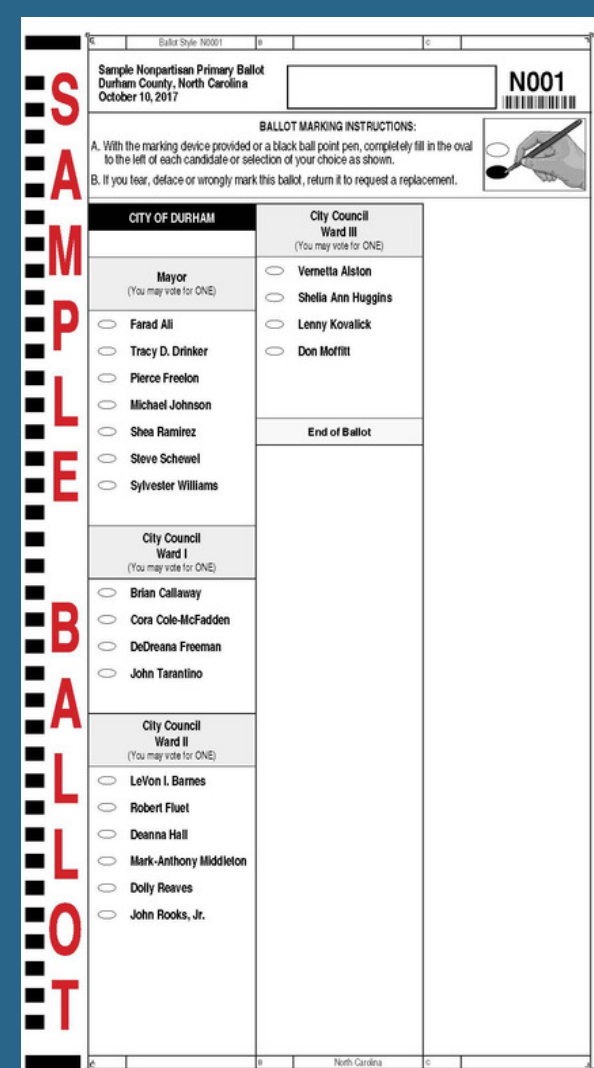
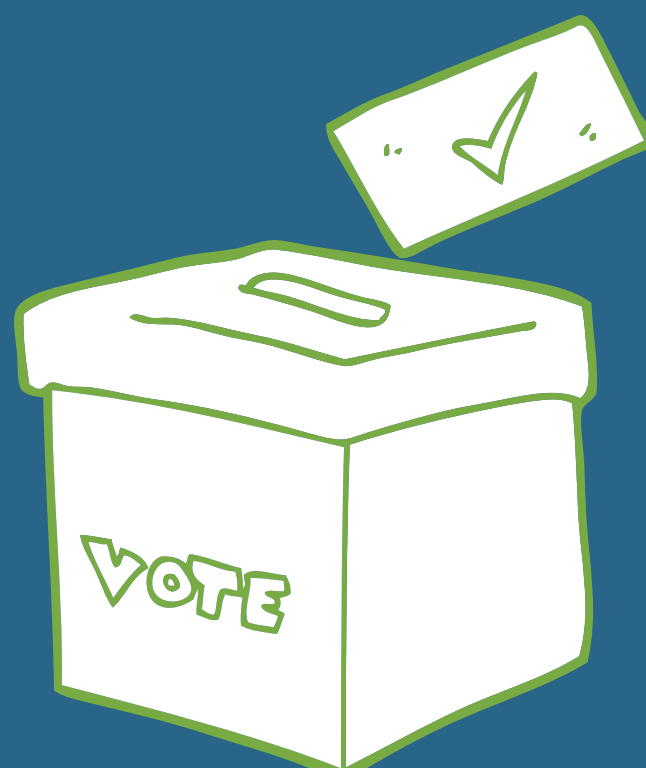


2018 PRIMARY & BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTIONS

During Early Voting, you can register and vote at the same time!
Just bring one of the following documents:

Current Photo Identification:

- NC Driver License or ID Card
- U.S. Military ID
- U.S. Passport
- Other Government-Issued Photo ID
- Student Photo ID
- Certified Naturalization Document

Current Name & Address Document:

- Utility Bill: Telephone; Cable; Water; Sewage; Electric or Gas
- Bank Statement or Bank-Issued Credit Card Statement
- Property Tax Bill
- Auto Registration
- Public Housing or Social Service Agency Document
- Paycheck or Paycheck Stub from Employer or W-2
- Government Paycheck; Invoice; Letter; or Document from Local, State, or U.S. Government Agency
