Ideally, this room will be accessible to a restroom (for urine collection for pregnancy and drug testing). Additionally, we are requesting a place to store two filing cabinets (that we will provide) for study documents. A part of this study involves study participants testing for HIV, gonorrhea and chlamydia at DCoDPH, so the involvement of DCoDPH staff will be essential for this study component. For enrollment, recruitment cards and fliers will be posted at the Health Department clinics in their lobby, waiting area, treatment rooms, or on the walls outside and in the surrounding areas.
