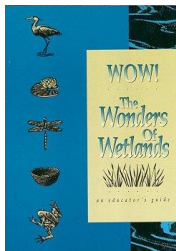

WOW! WONDERS OF WETLANDS



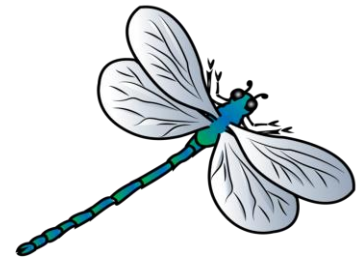
