This is an opportunity for the student to do independent study on a science topics and help meet NC DPI Essential Standards and Common Core Standards in the classroom.



### Theme - The Living Soil

All entries should reflect the theme's content and be a representation of what the student feels best exemplifies this topic. Students are encouraged to be original in their essay. The judges will be looking for informative entries that best relay the message to an audience while at the same time being original and creative.

### **Judging Criteria**

Students will be judged on:

Conservation Message
Visual Effectiveness
Universal Appeal
Originality
10%

Points will be deducted for the following infractions:

- Copyright violation -5 points
- Exceeding the size limit -5 points

### Official Rules - Graphic Design Poster, 9th grades

- This contest is for Graphic Design Posters using computer software.
- Posters should be designed so that if they were to be printed on paper they would be <u>no larger</u> than 24 X 36 in.
- Poster orientation may be portrait or landscape.
- Posters may be created using the software of the student's choice
- The poster must be submitted electronically in the following approved file format:

#### PDF, Adobe Acrobat File

- Electronic files can be submitted to jbrooks@dconc.gov by the Feb 8, 2019 5pm deadline
- All posters will be judged electronically. There is no requirement for them to be printed, but
  please design them as if they were going to be printed to make sure font and visuals are visible
  (also note that interactive design programs like Prezi look great online, but don't translate well on
  printed material)
- Posters must be the **original work** of the individual student. Original work is created by the student and shows a fresh, new idea. Students should be made aware of copy right protection.
- Posters must be the work of individual student, no team entries are allowed.
