This is an opportunity for the student to do independent study on a science topics and help meet NC DPI Essential Standards and Common Core Standards in the classroom.



Theme - The Living Soil

All entries should reflect the theme's content and be a representation of what the student feels best exemplifies this topic. Students are encouraged to be original in their design. The judges will be looking for the entries that best teaches the message to an audience while at the same time being original and creative.

Official Rules - Posters, 3rd - 6th grades

- NO NAMES ON THE FRONT, NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Posters should be <u>no larger than 24 x 36 inches</u> (no exceptions!)
- Posters must have the current theme incorporated into the poster, <u>preferably as the header/poster title</u>
- Pictures or other materials may be mounted on the posters, if mounted securely. Only materials that are flat or create a two-dimensional effect may be used. Mounted materials cannot stick out more than 1/8th of an inch from the paper.
- Any coloring materials available to students and suitable for poster work may be used.
- Posters must be the original work of the student. Original work is created by the student and shows a fresh, new idea. Hand drawn pictures are preferred over computer generated drawings.
- Posters must be the work of **individual** student, no team entries are allowed.
- Posters should be submitted flat and not rolled.
- Posters must be identified on the back <u>using the official registration form</u> (please see below)
