

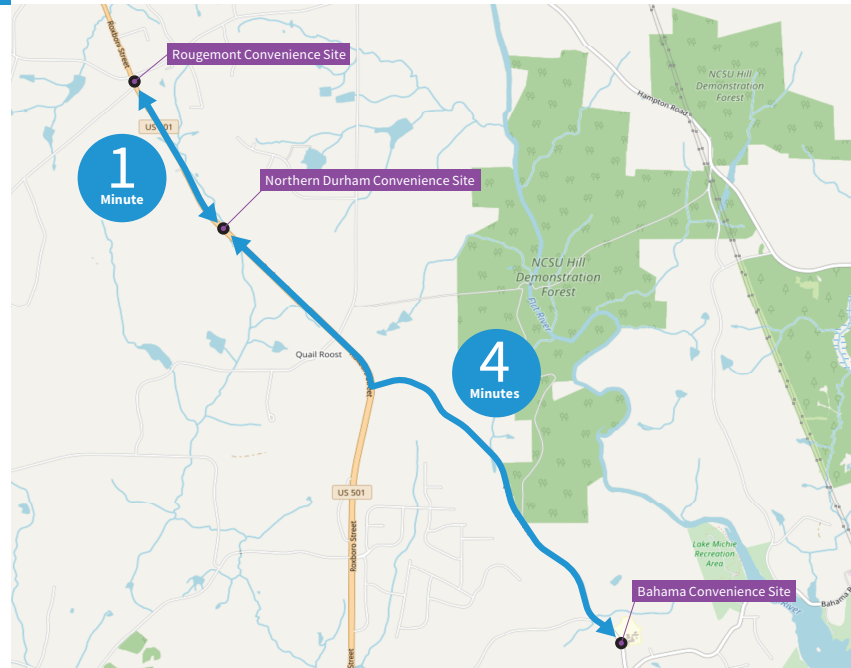
Northern Durham Convenience Site



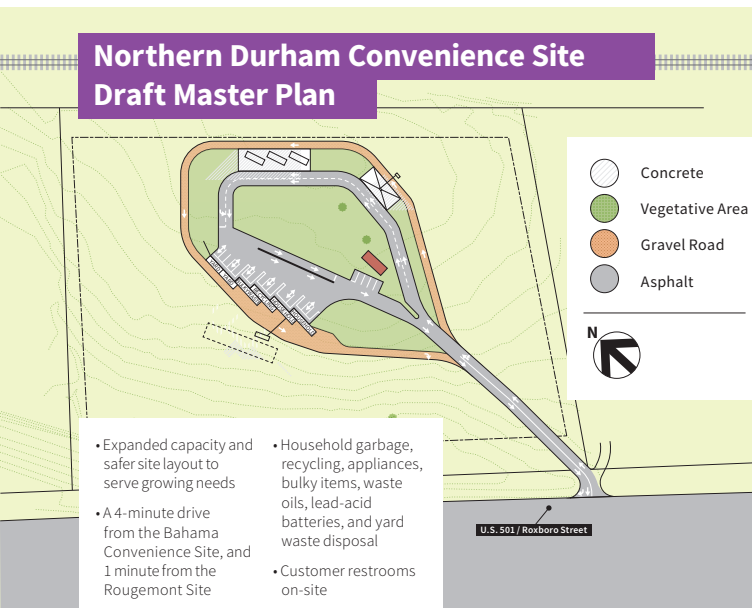
Project Purpose

Durham County is undertaking a master planning process to construct a new Convenience Site on US-501 between Bahama and Rougemont.

The new Northern Durham Convenience Site will replace both the Bahama and Rougemont Convenience Sites, which are located on leased land and must be closed. The larger, safer, and better-equipped facility will meet the growing needs of residents in the northern part of the county.



Northern Durham Convenience Site Draft Master Plan



- Expanded capacity and safer site layout to serve growing needs
- A 4-minute drive from the Bahama Convenience Site, and 1 minute from the Rougemont Site
- Household garbage, recycling, appliances, bulky items, waste oils, lead-acid batteries, and yard waste disposal
- Customer restrooms on-site

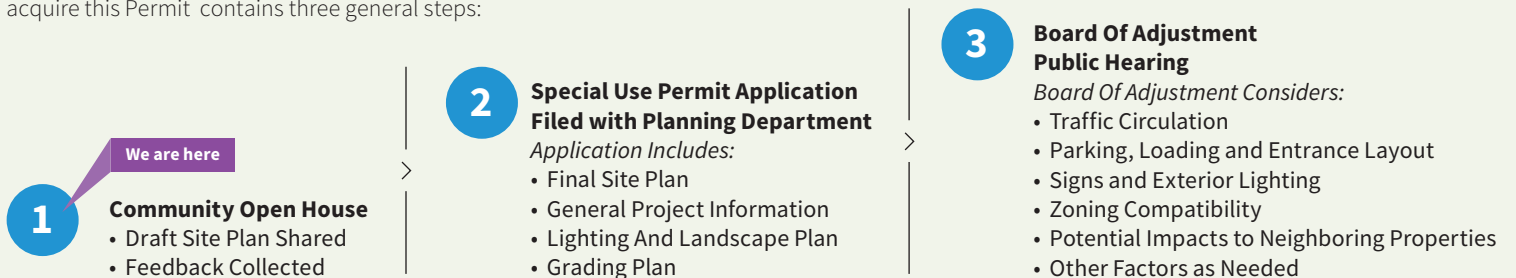
Benefits of a New Convenience Site

Minor Special Use Permit

In order to construct the Northern Durham Convenience Site on the proposed site, the County Board of Adjustment must grant a Minor Special Use Permit. The process to acquire this Permit contains three general steps:



Timeline

The Northern Durham Convenience Site is still in its master planning stage. Construction is expected to start in 2020, pending approval of the special use permit and site plan. Property acquisition, final design, and successful project bidding will also take place prior to the start of construction.
