Durham Joins Together –Data Subgroup 830-930am Brightleaf Square

Sherani reviewed data for NC and Durham for unintentional deaths. Durham County is in Health Director 5 group.

Interestingly, NC as a whole has 85% unintentional deaths in the white population and 11% Black; but unintentional deaths increase to 50% in Durham County.

There is a data break once patient is admitted to hospital.

There is also no data on Naloxone administrations in the community groups

John Paul from DC EMS is interested in joining group and will be a great asset.

Questions from this meeting:

- Is this group creating and analyzing data sets? OR identifying gaps in data available?
- Are the same treatment groups available to women as men?
- Are there options for women with children?
- Can data be divided even further into Durham City? Scott advised there is a possibility to get data by zip code (geocode).
 - This could be used to identify “hotspots” in City of Durham.
- How many prescribers in Durham County? In NC?
 - Sherani provided data from SAMHSA
