Using Durham County's Convenience Drop-off Sites

Durham County operates and maintains four staffed convenience drop-off sites listed on the back of this brochure. These convenience drop-off sites are for residential waste and recycling only. The sites DO NOT accept commercial waste or construction and demolition waste.

Unincorporated residents must display a current Solid WasteDecal in order to use these services. Solid Waste Decals are issued on a fiscal year basis and are included with your real estate tax bill which is mailed in late July/ early August. To purchase a decal, contact the Durham County Tax Office at 919-560-0300.

Recycling at Home



Durham County also provides curbside collection of recyclables for unincorporated residents every other week. Each home is issued one green 96 gallon recycling cart. Yard waste no larger than 6" in diameter or 8' in length (not available at site 4)
