

## Request for Approval of Property Tax Exemption, Exclusion, or Deferral Due to Showing of Good Cause for Failure to Make a Timely Application

An owner claiming an exemption, exclusion, or deferral from property taxes must file a timely application. Applications must be filed before the end of the listing period to be timely, except for applications for the homestead tax relief programs (G.S. 105-277.1, 105-277.1B, 105-277.1C) which must be filed by June 1 to be timely.

The application that you have submitted to our office was received after the application deadline and is considered untimely.

However, per G.S. 105-282.1(a1), if you can show good cause for failure to make a timely application, the application may be approved by the Board of Equalization and Review.

An untimely application for exemption or exclusion approved under this provision applies only to property taxes levied in the calendar year in which the untimely application is filed.

If you would like your application to be considered for the current year, please complete the request below and submit it to our office. Once we have received a completed request, our office will present the request and the untimely application to the Board of Equalization and Review for its consideration.
