ELECTIONEERING OUTSIDE VOTING SITES

Generally, electioneering is allowed at an area nearby the entrance to voting sites when voting is in progress. Electioneering is not allowed inside the voting enclosure, inside the voting site building, or an area immediately outside the voters' entrance to the building (this is called the "buffer zone"). Buffer zones as designated by <u>G.S. 163-166.4</u>: "county board of elections, shall where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet."

In Durham County, the buffer zone is set at 50 feet from the entrance at all sites, unless otherwise adjusted to prevent voter/electioneer hazards. The placement of political signage and advertising will be permitted at all voting sites outside of the designated buffer zone on Election Day.

When voting is in progress, election workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with signs, chalk, rope, tape, or other materials supplied by the Durham County Board of Elections.

Additionally, <u>electioneering will not be allowed in any designated curbside voting area per State</u> <u>Board of Elections Memorandum 2020-20</u>.

The following privately owned voting sites will not permit the placement of political signage at least 36 hours prior to the opening of the voting site and at least 36 hours after the close of the voting site unless otherwise provided by law. This limitation does not apply to other voting sites in Durham County. These voting places do allow the placement of political signage and advertising on Election Day (updated regularly):

- Triangle Grace Church (Election Day Precinct 53-1)
- Holy Infant Catholic Church (Election Day Precinct 16)
- Bahama Ruritan Club (Election Day Precinct 28)
- White Rock Baptist Church (Election Day Precinct 41)
- McMannen United Methodist Church (Election Day Precinct 50)
- Westminster Presbyterian Church (Election Day Precinct 56)
