# The Durham County Stay at Home Order: What Durham County Residents Should Know

#### What is a stay at home order?

A stay at home order requires residents to stay at home except for essential activities such as buying food, getting medical treatment or exercise

#### Do

Stay at home as much as possible (children too)

Go out only for essentials (food, medical care, etc.)

Go to work if your job is an essential service (health, food, etc.)

Stay at least six feet from others when you do go out

Exercise outside (hiking, walking, etc. if you can stay six feet from others)

Take your pets to the veterinarian

## **Don't**

Have play dates

Make non-essential trips

**Gather in groups** 

Go to work unless it is an essential service

Visit loved ones in hospital or long-term care facilities

Have visitors or non-essential workers in your home

Participate in contact/group sports
