 - **A.** Audit date The audit of the district books was done on June 16. Lisa Marochak thanked Laura Marie Davis, David Harris, and Talmage Layton for conducting the audit.

- F. Agriculture Cost Share Program (ACSP) and Agricultural Water Resources Program (AgWRAP)— Emily Bateman reported on the following:
 - **Funding**: Haven't received yet the FY21 allocation
 - Spot Check date: tabled until the next board meeting
- G. Stream Restoration and Stormwater Projects Eddie Culberson reported on the following:
 - **A. Grove Park Project** Staff was notified today that the district received another DWR grant for \$200,000 for the Grove Park Project. Total cost of this project is 1.3 million.
 - **B.** Marbrey/Jackson Project- There is a problem with twenty of the hard woods dying in the flood plains. The contractor has agreed to come back and fix the issue at no cost to the district.
 - **C. EWP** (Willowhaven)- funding estimate has come up short from what was initially estimated. 75% of the funding is through NRCS.
 - **Training** Indoor training has been postponed, but they are still planning to hold field visits in Durham.

H. Ag Development/Farmland Protection Advisory Board- Lisa Marochak report the following on behalf of Mike Dupree:

- Agriculture Economic Development (AED)Grant -The FY21 AED grant application will be
 released July 21, 2020. The application deadline is August 31, 2020 at 5:00 pm. Award
 recipients will be notified by letter no later than September 15, 2020. Grant information
 sessions will be held virtually (times and dates will be announced next week). Durham Soil and
 Water staff will provide one on one assistance to individuals in preparing applications for the
 grant program.
- Southeastern Sustainability Directors Network Grant (informational only)- The grantor has provided a one-year extension for the summers of 2021 and 2022. The BETC team will not be working this summer.
- Farmland Protection Advisory Board (FPAB)- last meeting was June 18, 2020 (Mike provided an update). The next meeting is scheduled for July 16, 2020 at 8:00 am via Zoom.
- I. Environmental Education Report-Lisa Marochak reported on the following:
 - Field days- potentially will be held virtually
 - **In-classroom or virtual trainings** waiting to see if students will be back in the classrooms this year. If not, staff will need to convert education trainings to online.
- J. Central Regional Coordinator- Allie Dinwiddie provided an NC Division of Soil and Water update to the board and guest.
 - All reappointments need to be submitted to the Division by October 30th. Deadline to file to run for an elected position was July 6.
 - The Soil and Water Commission is scheduled to meet on August 5 to consider the allocations for FY21.
 - There will be one regional batching period until the budget is approved.
 - The NC Farm Act passed with a couple of provisions.
 - Area IV Soil and Water Committee representatives- Laura Marie Davis volunteered to put her name in for the Community Conservation Committee. Danielle Adams announced that the Legislative Seat will be available because she isn't running for office this year.
- **K. NRCS Update-** NRCS Supervisory Soil Conservationist, Diana Irizarry presented a report to the board.
 - Still working on two applications for seasonal high tunnels.
 - Several potential applicants have recently contacted her
