AED Grant Committee held three Informational Training Sessions for the Grant Program. They were well attended virtually. Thirty-two applications were received by the August 31 deadline: 20 farmer, 4 school and 8 nonprofit applicants. Total funding amount requested was \$109,289. Applications have been ranked and funds will be allocated on September 15. The FY2022 allocation for this program is \$75,000.
