



Is Your Water Cut Off, Or Soon Will Be?

The State of NC has been awarded more than \$38 million in federal funding to establish a new water assistance program for households affected by the pandemic. The **Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)** This program is a temporary emergency program to assist those residents who have their water service cut-off, or in jeopardy of having it cut-off.
