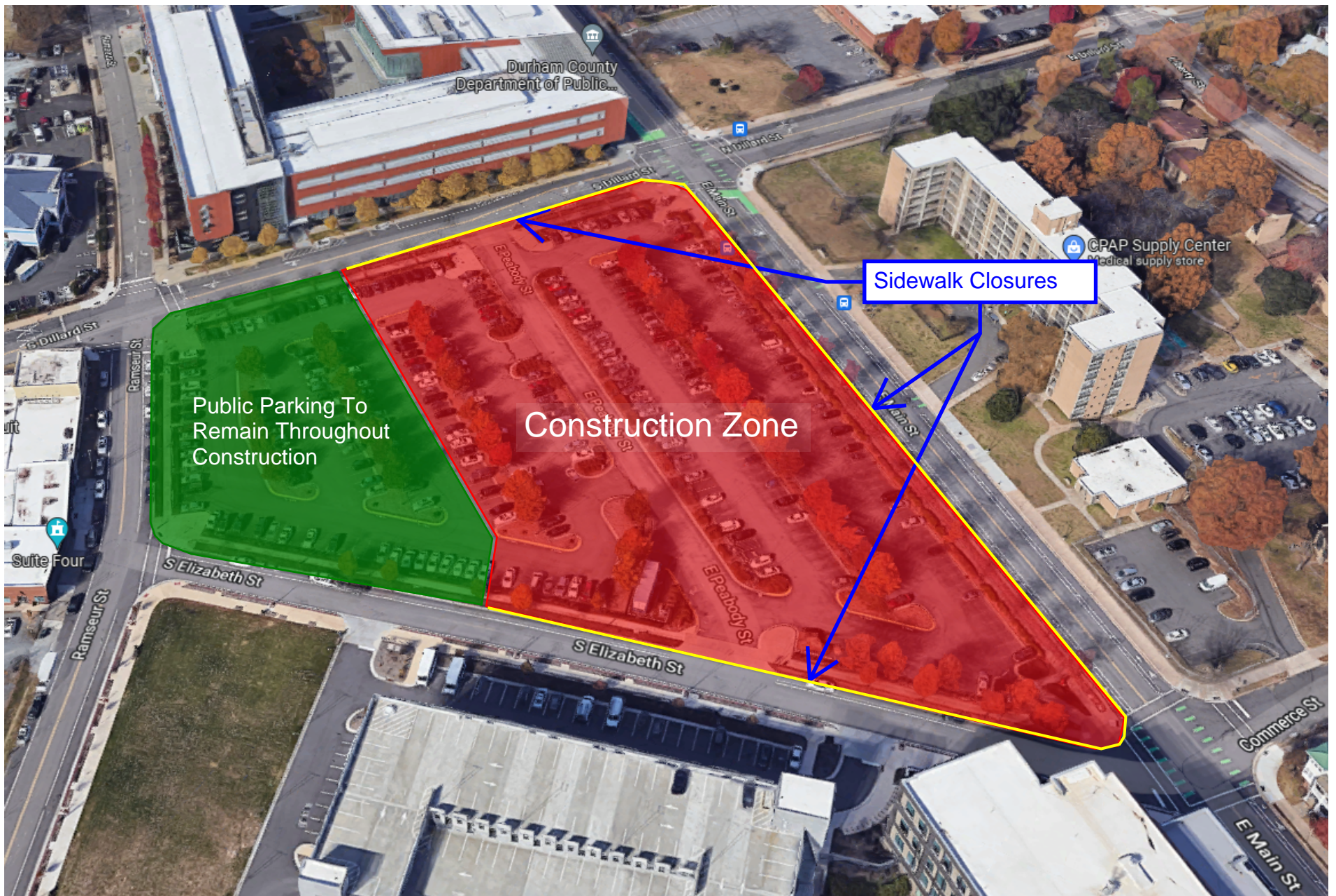

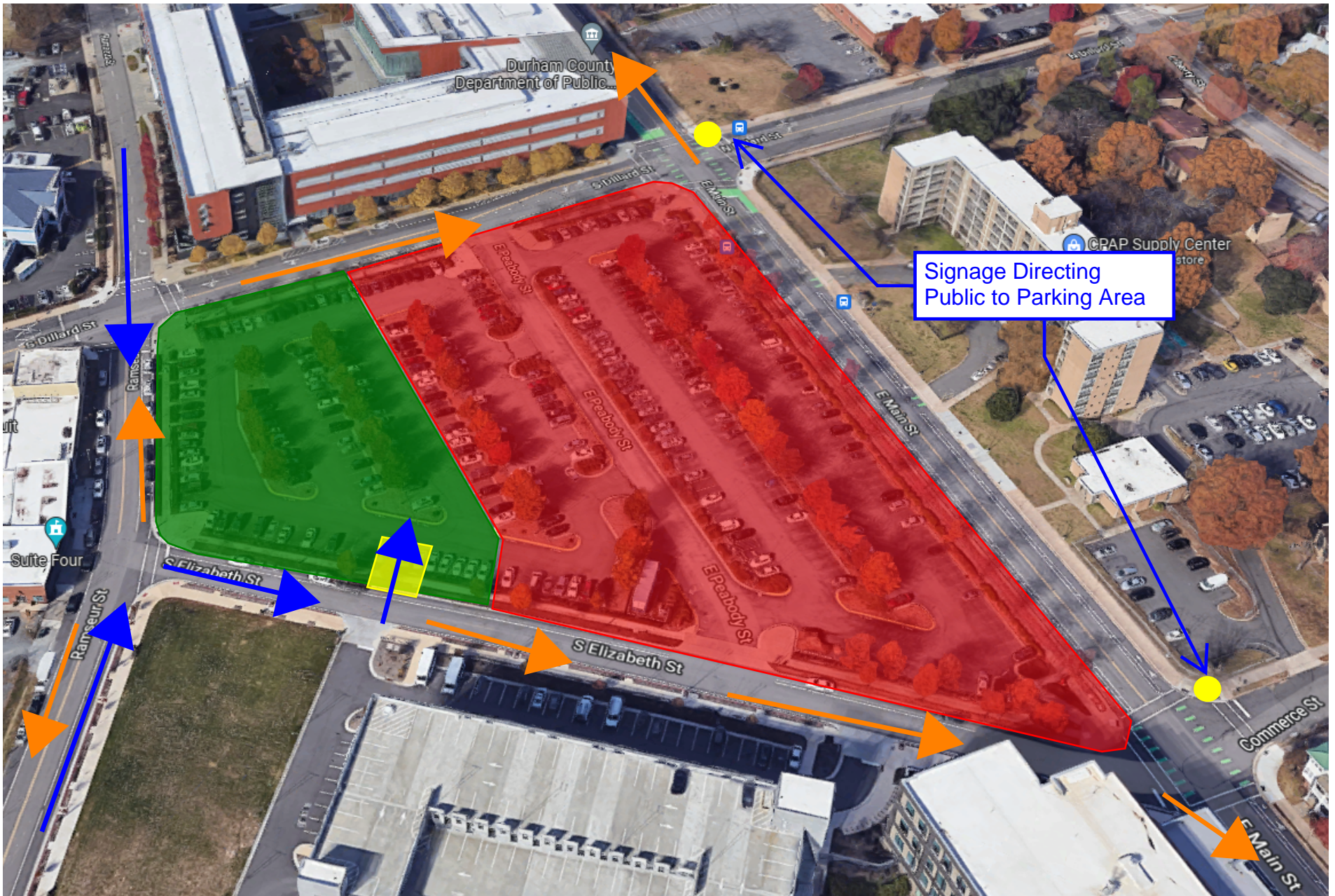


Work is currently planned to begin on May 2, 2022. The first activity will be the installation of a new entrance to the parking lot on Elizabeth Street. It is expected to take two weeks for this entrance to be installed. During that time, a select few spaces will be closed to allow for the construction of the entrance, but all other entrances, spaces, and pedestrian walkways within the lot will remain open.



Beginning May 16, 2022, the construction zone will be separated from the surrounding areas with fencing. Sidewalk closures around the construction zone on Elizabeth, Main, and Dillard Streets will be in effect. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians to crosswalks at the intersections of Elizabeth/Ramseur, Dillard/Ramseur, and Elizabeth/Main.

Vehicular Traffic



Beginning May 16, 2022, the new parking lot entrance from Elizabeth Street will be in place. This will be the only vehicular access to the parking lot. Preferred directions of approach are shown via the blue arrows above. Preferred directions of exiting the lot are shown via the orange arrows. Members of the public utilizing the preferred approach/exit paths will encounter the least amount of construction traffic and disruption to their travel.

Pedestrian Traffic

During construction, members of the public should utilize the new entrance on Elizabeth Street to access parking.

Because sidewalks around the construction zone will be closed, pedestrians will be directed via signage to the intersections of Dillard/Ramseur and Elizabeth/Ramseur for street crossings.
