








Census Tract 13.01




BCU Expanded Census Tract Focus










Over the past calendar year, here are the "Persons Shot" in BCU's initial target areas:



Over the past calendar year, here are the "Homicides" in BCU's initial target areas:




Over the past calendar year, here are the "Persons Shot" in BCU's expanded target areas:




Over the past calendar year, here are the "Homicides" in BCU's expanded target areas:



In FY22, a total of **864** mediations have been done by BCU staff. In **Q3** there were a total of **343** mediations. Monthly mediations increased in **Q3** due to increased staffing and monitoring of focus areas.



In FY22, a total of **1,365** mediations have been done by BCU staff. In **Q4** there were a total of **501** mediations. Monthly mediations increased in **Q4** due to increased staffing and monitoring of focus areas.




What is Project B.U.I.L.D?

 Project BUILD is a gang prevention and intervention program that follows the evidence based Comprehensive Gang Model. Project BUILD provides coordinated case management and intensive services to youth and young adults between the ages of 14 and 21 who are at high risk of gang involvement.

 Project BUILD's street outreach workers work one-on-one with young people to model pro-social behavior, support positive decision-making, connect youth to school and employment, and support involvement in positive activities.
