

Who qualifies for Cognitive Behavioral Intervention (CBI)?

18 years of age and older Involved with the Criminal Justice System Able to read/write

- The Justice Services Department (JSD) has a contract with North Carolina Division of Adult Corrections (NC DAC) to provide CBI to High Risk/High Need adults on probation, parole, and post release supervision.
- JSD accepts referrals from TASC (Treatment Alternatives for Safer Communities)
- JSD accepts referrals from court as part of a diversion agreement or deferred prosecution. Complete the <u>CBI referral form</u>
- JSD accepts referrals from Federal Probation

Referrals must be received from appropriate referral source prior to services.

About CBI classes:

- Available mornings, afternoons, or evening
- Meet twice weekly
- Each class last 1.5 hours
- Can be provided in 24 (standard), 16, 12, or 8 sessions
- Virtual classes available for some participants and must be approved by JSD staff
