

Strengths / Successes

- Increase in vaccine with state assistance

Challenges / Barriers

- Vaccine shortages
- No prior medical and vaccine records
- Language barriers
- Staffing shortages



Advantages

- Working closely with our resettlement agencies has allowed us to assist refugees from other counties
- Having temp staffing has allowed us to open more appointments

Disadvantages

 Trying to obtain primary care appointments for our refugees with our partners due to staffing shortages

• Since April 2022 17 Ukrainians have accessed Refugee Health Services.
