Funded artists might write poetry, paint, make sculptures, do performance art, or another form of art. No specific genre or experience is required. We seek to fund projects that use artistic expression to examine one or more of the following topics:

- Healthcare access and equity
- Trust in healthcare and health
   research
- Health-related misinformation
- Social, political, environmental, and/or economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic
- Mental health
- Or other

We will give priority consideration to journalistic organizations or projects that have an impact on historically marginalized demographics.

Funded artists will be paired with Be Connected Durham & Beyond to facilitate managing grant funds. Bull City Strong consultation will help ensure scientific accuracy of content creation. You should attribute funding to Bull City Strong in any communication about the project.

#### Award amounts

A total of three awards of \$5,000 and one award of \$15,000 will be given to the winning applicants. Please indicate which award amount you feel is necessary based on the scope of your project. Awardees are not guaranteed to receive their requested amount; award determinations will be made based on a number of factors when considering all applicants.
