

We seek to fund projects that use grassroots methods to promote awareness of health issues and healthy behaviors related to COVID-19. Any individual age 16 or older who lives in North Carolina, or an organization based in North Carolina, is eligible to apply. To be funded as a social influencer, you should have your own established audience in Durham, North Carolina. You may be a vocal member of a parent group, a small business owner that serves our community, or a student leader of a school organization, or have a large following online, or more. Some examples of what possible projects may focus on include:

- Healthcare access and equity
- Trust in healthcare and health research
- Health-related misinformation
- Social, political, environmental, and/or economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic
- Mental health
- Or other

We will give priority consideration to journalistic organizations or projects that have an impact on historically marginalized demographics.

Funded social influencers will be paired with Be Connected Durham & Beyond to facilitate managing grant funds. Bull City Strong consultation will help ensure scientific accuracy of content creation.

Award amounts

A total of three awards of \$5,000 and one award of \$15,000 will be given to the winning applicants. Please indicate which award amount you feel is necessary based on the scope of your project. Awardees are not guaranteed to receive their requested amount; award determinations will be made based on a number of factors when considering all applicants.
