2024 STATEWIDE SECOND PRIMARY

Quick Facts

- Two races from the Republican Primary will be on the ballot: NC Lieutenant Governor and NC State Auditor.
- Only registered Republicans and eligible Unaffiliated voters are able to participate.
 - Eligible Unaffiliated voters are those that either did not vote in the 3/5/2024 Statewide Primary and Election or voted in the Republican primary.
- Registered 17-year-olds who will be 18 by the date of the November 5th General Election and fall into one of the above categories will be able to participate in the Second Primary.
- No new voter registrations submitted after the February 9th deadline will be processed unless permitted by law.
- Photo ID will be required to vote.

VOTE EARLY!

- Early voting is April 25th – May 11th.
- Avoid long lines and vote early.

VOTE BY-MAIL!

- Request a no-excuse absentee-by-mail ballot fully online on or before May 7th.
- Track your ballot from the point of distribution until it is returned to the BOE.

- Election Day voting will occur on May 14th at your home precinct's polling place.
- The polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.
