

# Your Guide to the 2024 **Second Primary**



This election is a continuation of the 2024 March Primary and is taking place to decide two statewide nominees for the **Republican** party.

**Early Voting**  
April 25 - May 11

**Election Day**  
May 14



## Who is eligible?

**Only the following voters are able to participate in the Second Primary:**

- Republican voters
- Unaffiliated voters who voted a Republican ballot during the March Primary
- Unaffiliated voters who did not vote in the March Primary

All other voters will not have an available ballot style in the electronic pollbook and will only be able to vote provisionally.



## No New Voter Registrations

New voter registrations are not permitted between the dates of the first and second primaries. This does not apply to individuals that become eligible to vote between the first and second primaries for Election Day voters.

There will be **no** Same-Day Registration during Early Voting!



## One Ballot Style

As the races in the Second Primary are statewide and only include Republican candidates, there will only be one ballot style for all eligible Durham County voters.

## Two Races



The two races on the ballot are NC Lieutenant Governor and NC State Auditor. The winners will appear on the General Election ballot for their respective races later this year.
