2024 GENERAL ELECTION

Quick Facts

- Federal, State, and Local offices will be on the ballot.
- State and local Bond Referendums will be on the ballot.
- Party is not a factor and voters will receive ballots based on their jurisdictional assignments.
- All ballots will be two-sided.
- Photo ID will be required to vote.
- October 11th is the regular voter registration deadline.
- The election will be certified on November 15th.

VOTE EARLY!

- Early voting is October 17th - November 2nd.
- Avoid long lines and vote early.

VOTE BY-MAIL!

- Request a no-excuse absentee by-mail ballot fully online on or before October 29th .
- Track your ballot from the point of distribution until it is returned to the BOE.

- Election Day voting will occur on November 5th at your home precinct's polling place.
- The polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.
