## Mental Health Court Diversion Program (MHCDP)Participation Fact Sheet

- Participation is Voluntary. But once accepted, into the MHCDP you will be responsible to abide by the following conditions or risk being removed from the program.
- You must meet with the Mental Health Court Coordinator and Mental Health Case Manager as agreed upon in the Person-Centered Plan.
- You must comply with any and all treatment recommendations made by the Mental Health Court Coordinator and Community Mental Health Provider (i.e. Individual Therapy, Group Therapy, Medication Management).
- You must take all medications as prescribed.
- There will be Random Urine Drug Screens to which you are required to submit. You must remain **Alcohol and Drug Free** throughout the program.
- You must attend all scheduled Court Sessions monthly.
- You must meet all conditions of the Deferral Agreement (when applicable).
- You must not pick up new charges while in the Durham County Mental Health Court Diversion Program.
- You must meet monthly with your assigned Attorney.
- You must report any changes regarding addresses, phone number and emails immediately to the Mental Health Court Coordinator.
