Introductions

All Board members introduced themselves by stating name and role.

Approval of Minutes:

TAB approved minutes from July 10, 2012 meeting. Motion made by Kilsheimer, seconded by Burton (passed unanimously).

Performance Reports:

Performance reports were reviewed for July and August 2012. YTD expenses for some of the agencies and TPP (DCA service directly to general public who are 60 or older or have a disability) are high and we will track them for the next couple of months to determine if changes need to be made to service. Caldwell will provide narrative of complaints from DCA and DATA Access passengers.

Updates:

Scully and Caldwell provided a brief report of a legal issue impacting a City passenger and First Transit driver, but not DCA at this time.

Scully provided an update on the State DHHS action toward developing a statewide brokerage system for all Medicaid-NEMT service. Lewis and Thomas explained policy and procedure changes that the STATE DHHS office has required local DSS Medicaid offices implement beginning in January 2012 and noted that a compliance review will be conducted by January 2013.

New Business:

Stephani DeBerry of DSCL provided a summary of senior programs encouraging independent travel on public transportation.

The TAB approved the following additional service allocation requests for FY13. Motion made by Kilsheimer, seconded by Sanders, (passed unanimously).
