Call to Order

Chairman Reckhow called the Closed Session to order.

Request for Board Action

Deputy County Manager Wendell Davis said the purpose of the Closed Session was to instruct the County staff concerning the position to be taken in negotiating a proposed contract for the acquisition of real property owned by Crown of Righteousness Community Church at 6122 Barbee Road and the adjacent lot.

Mr. Davis began his presentation to the Board of County Commissioners by providing a brief history of the actions taken to purchase the property.

During the week of September 23, 2002 staff scheduled a meeting with Pastor Gregory David to discuss the acquisition. Pastor David implied that he must place the matter before his board at its next meeting in November.

On November 25, 2002 staff received a response from Pastor David that the Church was unwilling to sell the land.

Given the outcome of these negotiations, the staff recommendation was to consider other, alternative locations in the south.
