5. Register of Deeds Willie L. Covington Receives Archives Award from The Federation of Genealogical Societies

Durham County Register of Deeds Willie L. Covington has received the Archives Award from the Federation of Genealogical Societies. The Archives Award is presented to an organization or an individual in recognition of exceptional contributions in the area of archival access, preservation, or services. It recognizes individuals, programs or organizations that have worked to preserve or increase the availability of original historical documents in any format. The Archives Award was presented on September 8 at the organization's annual conference by Patricia A. Oxley, President of the Federal of Genealogical Societies.

According to Janice A. Fritsch, FGS Award Committee Chair, "Mr. Covington recognized the need to take swift action to preserve the Durham County vital records (birth, delayed birth, marriages and deaths) that were in a rapid state of deterioration.
