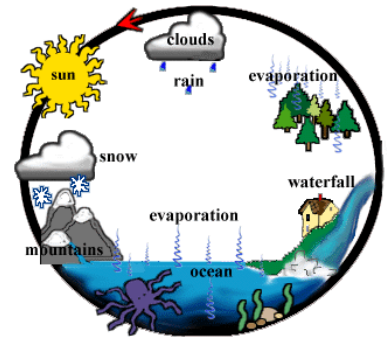




2012-2013 Conservation Contests Winners

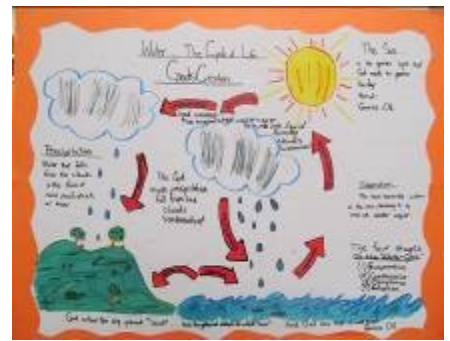

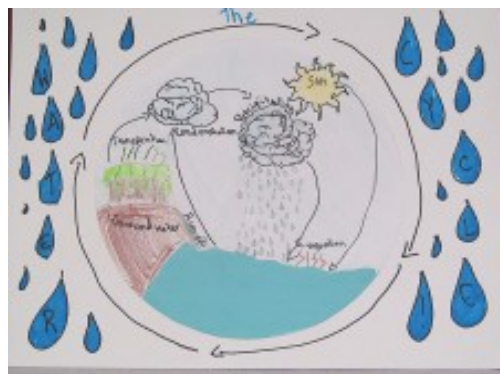

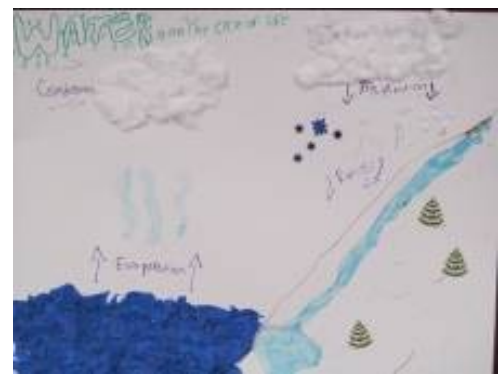
