EXTENSION TO CONTRACT

THIS EXTENSION is made and entered into this ___day of _____, 2013 by and between the **COUNTY OF DURHAM** (hereinafter referred to as “**County**”) and _____ (hereinafter referred to as “**Contractor**”).

WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, the County and Contractor previously entered into a contract dated _____, for the provision of _____, (hereinafter the “Original Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the County and Contractor desire to **renew/extend** the Original Agreement, while keeping in effect all terms and conditions of the Original Agreement not inconsistent with the terms and conditions set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration for the mutual covenants and agreements made herein, the parties agree to extend the Original Agreement as follows:

1. The Term of the Original Agreement is hereby renewed/extended through _____.
2. The compensation paid to the Contractor for this renewed/extended term shall be an amount not to exceed \$_____.
3. The Living Wage Rate for Fiscal Year 2014 (July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014) is \$12.17.
4. Contract Monitoring. The County will perform on-going contract monitoring to ensure that the terms of the Original Agreement, as amended or extended from time to time, are complied with. Contractor agrees to cooperate with the County in its monitoring process and provide documentation and/or information requested during the term of this Agreement for the purpose of monitoring the services provided by Contractor.
5. Except for the changes made herein, the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect to the extent not inconsistent with this agreement. In the event that there is a conflict between the Original Agreement and this agreement, this agreement shall control.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have expressed their agreement to these terms by causing this Contract Extension to be executed by their duly authorized office or agent. This Contract Extension shall be effective as of the date herein.
