1. <u>Citizen Comments</u> (30 min)

1) The Board of County Commissioners will provide a 30-minute comment period at the beginning of its Worksession meeting on the first Monday of each month. Any citizen of Durham County wishing to speak shall have an opportunity to do so. The Board may direct staff to research and reply to the concerns, if appropriate. Speakers must sign in prior to the start of the meeting providing a mail/email address and telephone number so that staff may reply to comments and/or questions. Citizens who request an immediate response from the Board are encouraged to submit a brief description of the issue to the Clerk to the Board two weeks prior to the Worksession to allow an opportunity for research prior to the meeting. All speakers shall have three minutes to speak and are requested to refrain from addressing issues related to personnel matters.

<u>County Manager's Recommendation</u>: The Manager recommends that the Board receive citizen comments and direct staff to respond, as deemed appropriate.

2. <u>Lincoln Community Health Center (LCHC) & Duke University Health System</u> (DUHS) Collaboration on a Unified Electronic Health (20 min)

- 1) The Board is requested to assist with \$500,000.00 in financial support for the implementation of the DUHS Epic (Maestro Care) Electronic Health Record at LCHC. As part of ongoing efforts to improve the quality and efficiency and lower the costs of healthcare provided to medically underserved patients in Durham County, LCHC has requested and DUHS desires to assist LCHC with the implementation, access and use of a common Electronic Health Record with a new Unified Database for patients served by the two institutions. LCHC has stated that it does not have the funds to participate in the implementation and requests County assistance.
- 2) <u>Alignment with Strategic Plan:</u> This initiative is consistent with LCHC's goal for meaningful use of health information technology to improve the quality and lower the cost of health care services in Durham County. The initiative aligns with Goal 2, Health and Well-being for All.

3. 2013 Annual Report - Durham Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board (10 min)

4. Memorial Stadium Authority Annual Report (10 min)

- 1) The Board is requested to formally review, discuss and accept the Durham County Memorial Stadium's Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2013 as presented by the Stadium Authority. The annual report summarizes the operation, financial condition, event schedule and the Stadium's Fiscal Year 2014 year to date financial position.
- 2) Alignment with Strategic Plan: This agenda item aligns with Goal 2: Health and Wellbeing for all by providing an avenue for adults and youth to engage in physical exercise and activities including football, lacrosse, soccer and track and field; as well as, Goal 5: Accountable, Efficient and Visionary Government through the use of the Stadium as an economic generator for tourism.

6. Classification and Compensation Study for Durham County (60 min)

- 2) The Board authorized the County Manager to enter into a contract with Evergreen Solutions to conduct a comprehensive review of the County's classification and compensation system. This review involved conducting a compensation and benefits survey; completing a market equity analysis of employee salaries; performing an analysis of all positions and identifying essential duties; reviewing the current job evaluation methodology; and working with County officials to establish a compensation philosophy.
- 3) The presentation will summarize the results of the study and Evergreen's recommendations for implementation.
- 4) Alignment with Strategic Plan: This request relates to the following elements of the Durham County Strategic Plan: the effort aligns with Goal #1 (Community and Family Prosperity and Enrichment) and Goal #5 (Accountable, Efficient, and Visionary Government).
